6 adult incontinent pads and pants.

7 **Sec. 70.** RCW 82.08.0283 and 1991 c 250 s 2 are each amended to
8 read as follows:

9 (1) The tax levied by RCW 82.08.020 shall not apply to sales of
10 insulin and items necessary for injecting insulin; prosthetic ((and))
11 devices; orthotic devices prescribed for an individual by a person
12 licensed under chapters 18.25, 18.57, or 18.71 RCW ((or)); hearing aids
13 dispensed or fitted by a person licensed under chapter 18.35 RCW and
14 hearing aid batteries; medicines of mineral, animal, and botanical
15 origin prescribed, administered, dispensed, or used in the treatment of
16 an individual by a person licensed under chapter 18.36A RCW; ostomic
17 items; durable medical equipment prescribed for an individual by a
18 person authorized by the state to prescribe durable medical equipment;
19 and medically prescribed oxygen. In addition, the tax levied by RCW
20 82.08.020 shall not apply to sales or charges made for tangible
21 personal property consumed and for labor and services rendered in the

28 chapter 18.57 or 18.71 RCW for use in the medical treatment of that
29 individual.

30 (b) "Durable medical equipment" includes, but is not limited to,
31 wheelchairs, hospital beds, standing aids, walking aids, bathroom aids,
32 aids to daily living, lifting devices and chairs, and parts and
33 accessories of all such durable medical equipment.
