5 On page 5, after line 27, insert the following:

6 "Sec. 6. RCW 70.128.060 and 1995 c 260 s 4 are each amended to
7 read as follows:

8 (1) An application for license shall be made to the department upon
9 forms provided by it and shall contain such information as the
10 department reasonably requires.

11 (2) The department shall issue a license to an adult family home if
12 the department finds that the applicant and the home are in compliance
13 with this chapter and the rules adopted under this chapter, unless (a)
14 the applicant has prior violations of this chapter relating to the
15 adult family home subject to the application or any other adult family
16 home, or of any other law regulating residential care facilities within
17 the past five years that resulted in revocation or nonrenewal of a
18 license; or (b) the applicant has a history of significant
19 noncompliance with federal, state, or local laws, rules, or regulations
20 relating to the provision of care or services to vulnerable adults or
21 to children.

22 (3) The license fee shall be submitted with the application.

23 (4) The department shall serve upon the applicant a copy of the
24 decision granting or denying an application for a license. An
25 applicant shall have the right to contest denial of his or her
26 application for a license as provided in chapter 34.05 RCW by
27 requesting a hearing in writing within twenty-eight days after receipt
28 of the notice of denial.

29 (5) The department shall not issue a license to a provider if the
30 department finds that the provider or any partner, officer, director,
31 managerial employee, or owner of five percent or more if the provider
32 has a history of significant noncompliance with federal or state
33 regulations, rules, or laws in providing care or services to vulnerable
34 adults or to children.

35 (6) The department shall license an adult family home for the
36 maximum level of care that the adult family home may provide. The
37 department shall define, in rule, license levels based upon the

1 education, training, and caregiving experience of the licensed provider
2 or staff.

3 (7) The department shall establish, by rule, standards used to
4 license nonresident providers and multiple facility operators. No more
5 than three adult family homes may be operated in this state by a
6 multiple facility operator at any one time.

7 (8) The department shall establish, by rule, for multiple facility
8 operators educational standards substantially equivalent to recognized
9 national certification standards for residential care administrators.

10 (9) The license fee shall be set at fifty dollars per year for each
11 home. A fifty dollar processing fee shall also be charged each home
12 when the home is initially licensed."

13 Renumber the remaining section consecutively and correct the title
14 accordingly.
