6 "Sec. 4. RCW 46.01.260 and 1994 c 275 s 14 are each amended to
7 read as follows:

8 (1) Except as provided in subsection (2) of this section, the
9 director, in his or her discretion, may destroy applications for
10 vehicle licenses, copies of vehicle licenses issued, applications for
11 drivers' licenses, copies of issued drivers' licenses, certificates of
12 title and registration or other documents, records or supporting papers
13 on file in his or her office which have been microfilmed or
14 photographed or are more than five years old. If the applications for
15 vehicle licenses are renewal applications, the director may destroy
16 such applications when the computer record thereof has been updated.

17 (2)(a) The director shall not destroy records of convictions or
18 adjudications of RCW 46.61.520 and 46.61.522 and shall maintain such
19 records permanently on file.

20 (b) The director shall not, within ten years from the date of
21 conviction, adjudication, or entry of deferred prosecution, destroy
22 records of the following:

23 (i) Convictions or adjudications of the following offenses: RCW
24 46.61.502(~~(7)~~) or 46.61.504(~~(7, 46.61.520(1)(a), or 46.61.522(1)(b))~~);

25 (ii) If the offense was originally charged as one of the offenses
26 designated in (a) or (b)(i) of this subsection, convictions or
27 adjudications of the following offenses: RCW 46.61.500 or 46.61.525,
28 or any other violation that was originally charged as one of the
29 offenses designated in (a) or (b)(i) of this subsection; or

30 (iii) Deferred prosecutions granted under RCW 10.05.120.

31 (~~(b)~~) (c) For purposes of RCW 46.52.100 and 46.52.130, offenses
32 subject to this subsection shall be considered "alcohol-related"
33 offenses."
