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5 On page 8, after line 17, insert the following:

6 "Sec. 9. RCW 28A.600.020 and 1990 c 33 s 497 are each amended to  
7 read as follows:

8 (1) The rules adopted pursuant to RCW 28A.600.010 shall be  
9 interpreted to insure that the optimum learning atmosphere of the  
10 classroom is maintained, and that the highest consideration is given to  
11 the judgment of qualified certificated educators regarding conditions  
12 necessary to maintain the optimum learning atmosphere.

13 (2) Any student who creates a disruption of the educational process  
14 in violation of the building disciplinary standards while under a  
15 teacher's immediate supervision may be excluded by the teacher from his  
16 or her individual classroom and instructional or activity area for all  
17 or any portion of the balance of the school day or until the principal  
18 or designee and teacher have conferred, whichever occurs first(~~(:~~  
19 ~~PROVIDED, That~~)). Except in emergency circumstances, the teacher  
20 ((shall have)) first ((attempted)) must attempt one or more alternative  
21 forms of corrective action((:PROVIDED FURTHER, That)). In no event  
22 without the consent of the teacher ((shall)) may an excluded student  
23 ((be returned)) return to the class during the balance of that class or  
24 activity period. This subsection does not apply when a teacher or  
25 principal imposes sanctions authorized under section 8 of this act.

26 (3) In order to preserve a beneficial learning environment for all  
27 students and to maintain good order and discipline in each classroom,  
28 every school district board of directors shall provide that written  
29 procedures are developed for administering discipline at each school  
30 within the district. Such procedures shall be developed with the  
31 participation of parents and the community, and shall provide that the  
32 teacher, principal or designee, and other authorities designated by the  
33 board of directors, make every reasonable attempt to involve the parent  
34 or guardian and the student in the resolution of student discipline  
35 problems. Such procedures shall provide that students may be excluded  
36 from their individual classes or activities for periods of time in  
37 excess of that provided in subsection (2) of this section if such

1 students have repeatedly disrupted the learning of other students:  
2 PROVIDED, That the procedures are consistent with the regulations of  
3 the state board of education and provide for early involvement of  
4 parents in attempts to improve the student's behavior: PROVIDED  
5 FURTHER, That pursuant to RCW 28A.400.110, the procedures shall assure  
6 that all staff work cooperatively toward consistent enforcement of  
7 proper student behavior throughout each school as well as within each  
8 classroom."

9       Renumber the remaining sections consecutively and correct the title  
10 and any internal references accordingly.

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
