7 "Sec. 1. RCW 75.28.011 and 1993 sp.s. c 17 s 34 are each amended
8 to read as follows:

9 (1) Unless otherwise provided in this title, a license issued under
10 this chapter is not transferable from the license holder to any other
11 person.

12 (2) The following restrictions apply to transfers of commercial
13 fishery licenses, salmon delivery licenses, and salmon charter licenses
14 that are transferable between license holders:

15 (a) The license holder shall surrender the previously issued
16 license to the department.

17 (b) The department shall complete no more than one transfer of the
18 license in any seven-day period.

19 (c) The fee to transfer a license from one license holder to
20 another is:

21 (i) The same as the resident license renewal fee if the license is
22 not limited under chapter 75.30 RCW; ~~((or))~~

23 (ii) Three and one-half times the resident renewal fee if the
24 license is not a commercial salmon license and the license is limited
25 under chapter 75.30 RCW~~((-))~~;

26 ~~((+))~~ (iii) Fifty dollars if the license is a commercial salmon
27 license and is limited under chapter 75.30 RCW; or

28 (iv) If a license is transferred from a resident to a nonresident,
29 ((the transferee shall pay)) the difference between the resident and
30 nonresident license fees at the time of transfer, to be paid by the
31 transferee.

32 (3) A commercial license that is transferable under this title
33 survives the death of the holder. Though such licenses are not
34 personal property, they shall be treated as analogous to personal
35 property for purposes of inheritance and intestacy. Such licenses are
36 subject to state laws governing wills, trusts, estates, intestate

1 succession, and community property, except that such licenses are
2 exempt from claims of creditors of the estate and tax liens. The
3 surviving spouse, estate, or beneficiary of the estate may apply for a
4 renewal of the license. There is no fee for transfer of a license from
5 a license holder to the license holder's surviving spouse or estate, or
6 to a beneficiary of the estate."
