- 6 "NEW SECTION. Sec. 5. The intent of this act is to create the

- NEW SECTION. Sec. 9. Information gathered through this act shall not be used to change or recommend change to the scope of practice of any health care profession nor shall the commission, the information advisory council, or its successor, advise or undertake to change such scope of practice."

- 9 EFFECT: Repeals the Health Personnel Resources Plan. Further, the 10 information advisory council is required to establish a health care professional information data system which shall identify the type, 11 number, and location of health care professionals working in the state, 12 13 and create a centralized inventory of applications, matriculations, and graduations from all health care training programs in the state in 14 15 vocational-technical training, community colleges, and four-year colleges and universities. The Higher Education Coordinating Board is 16 required to consider data from the Health Care Professional Information 17 18 Data System in operating the health professions scholarship and forgivable loan program.
