The legislature recognizes that the state of Washington has a rich agricultural history and that agriculture 8 continues to be one of the most basic and important industries of the 9 state. The legislature finds that the growth of this vital industry 10 requires that students continue to receive vocational agriculture 11 12 instruction from trained and qualified vocational agriculture 13 The legislature further finds that the number of instructors. qualified vocational agriculture educators is declining. 14 15 legislature finds that a vocational agriculture teacher recruitment 16 is necessary to protect the educational and program 17 opportunities for students with interests in vocational agriculture.
- NEW SECTION. Sec. 2. A new section is added to chapter 28A.415

  19 RCW to read as follows:
- 20 (1) The Washington state vocational agriculture teacher recruitment 21 program is established. The program shall be designed by the state 22 board of education, in consultation with the higher education 23 coordinating board, representatives of institutions of education, education organizations having an interest in teacher 24 25 recruitment issues, state-wide agricultural business organizations, 26 organizations having an interest in agriculture education, the superintendent of public instruction, the state board for community and 27 28 technical colleges, and the department of agriculture. 29 shall be designed to recruit students who are in grades nine through 30 twelve and adults who have entered other occupations to be future 31 vocational agriculture teachers.
  - (2) The program shall include the following:
- (a) Encouraging students in grades nine through twelve to acquire the academic and related skills necessary to prepare for the study of vocational agriculture at an institution of higher education;

- 1 (b) Promoting vocational agriculture teaching career opportunities 2 to develop an awareness of the opportunities in the education 3 profession;
- 4 (c) Providing opportunities for students to experience the 5 application of regular high school course work to activities related to 6 a teaching career in vocational agriculture;
- 7 (d) Providing information on the transferability of skills learned 8 in other occupations and professions to activities related to a 9 teaching career in vocational agriculture;
- 10 (e) Providing opportunities for underrepresented populations to 11 participate in activities related to a teaching career in vocational 12 agriculture; and
- (f) Providing for increased cooperation among institutions of higher education including community colleges, the superintendent of public instruction, the state board of education, and local school districts in working toward the goals of the program.
- NEW SECTION. **Sec. 3.** If specific funding for the purposes of this act, referencing this act by bill number, is not provided by June 30, 19 1995, in the omnibus appropriations act, this act is null and void."
