5 Strike everything after the enacting clause and insert the  
6 following:

7 NEW SECTION. **Sec. 1.** A new section is added to chapter 82.08 RCW  
8 to read as follows:

9 The tax levied by RCW 82.08.020 shall not apply to sales to health  
10 or social welfare organizations, as defined in RCW 82.04.431, of items  
11 necessary for new construction of alternative housing for youth in  
12 crisis, so long as the facility will be a licensed agency under chapter  
13 74.15 RCW, upon completion. This section shall expire July 1, 1997.

14 NEW SECTION. **Sec. 2.** A new section is added to chapter 82.12 RCW  
15 to read as follows:

16 The provisions of this chapter shall not apply in respect to the  
17 use of any item acquired by a health or social welfare organization, as  
18 defined in RCW 82.04.431, of items necessary for new construction of  
19 alternative housing for youth in crisis, so long as the facility will  
20 be a licensed agency under chapter 74.15 RCW, upon completion. This  
21 section shall expire July 1, 1997.

22 NEW SECTION. **Sec. 3.** For the purposes of sections 1 and 2 of this  
23 act, "youth in crisis" means any youth under eighteen years of age who  
24 is either: Homeless; a runaway from the home of a parent, guardian, or  
25 legal custodian; abused; neglected; abandoned by a parent, guardian, or  
26 legal custodian; or suffering from a substance abuse or mental  
27 disorder.

28 NEW SECTION. **Sec. 4.** This act is necessary for the immediate  
29 preservation of the public peace, health, or safety, or support of the  
30 state government and its existing public institutions, and shall take  
31 effect immediately."
