8 amended to read as follows:

9 (1) Tuition fees shall be established under the provisions of this
10 chapter.

11 (2) Academic year tuition for full-time students at the state's
12 institutions of higher education for the 1995-96 academic year, other
13 than the summer term, shall be as provided in this subsection.

14 (a) At the University of Washington and Washington State
15 University:

16 (i) For resident undergraduate students and other resident students
17 not in graduate study programs or enrolled in programs leading to the
18 degrees of doctor of medicine, doctor of dental surgery, and doctor of
19 veterinary medicine, two thousand seven hundred sixty-four dollars;

20 (ii) For nonresident undergraduate students and other nonresident
21 students not in graduate study programs or enrolled in programs leading
22 to the degrees of doctor of medicine, doctor of dental surgery, and
23 doctor of veterinary medicine, eight thousand two hundred sixty-eight
24 dollars;

25 (iii) For resident graduate and law students not enrolled in
26 programs leading to the degrees of doctor of medicine, doctor of dental
27 surgery, and doctor of veterinary medicine, four thousand four hundred
28 ninety dollars;

29 (iv) For nonresident graduate and law students not enrolled in
30 programs leading to the degrees of doctor of medicine, doctor of dental
31 surgery, and doctor of veterinary medicine, eleven thousand six hundred
32 thirty-four dollars;

33 (v) For resident students enrolled in programs leading to the
34 degrees of doctor of medicine, doctor of dental surgery, and doctor of
35 veterinary medicine, seven thousand four hundred ninety-seven dollars;
36 and

1 (vi) For nonresident students enrolled in programs leading to the
2 degrees of doctor of medicine, doctor of dental surgery, and doctor of
3 veterinary medicine, nineteen thousand four hundred thirty-one dollars.

4 (b) At the regional universities and The Evergreen State College:

5 (i) For resident undergraduate and all other resident students not
6 in graduate study programs, two thousand forty-five dollars;

7 (ii) For nonresident undergraduate and all other nonresident
8 students not in graduate study programs, seven thousand nine hundred
9 ninety-two dollars;

10 (iii) For resident graduate students, three thousand four hundred
11 forty-three dollars; and

12 (iv) For nonresident graduate students, eleven thousand seventy-one
13 dollars.

14 (c) At the community colleges:

15 (i) For resident students, one thousand two hundred twelve dollars;
16 and

17 (ii) For nonresident students, five thousand one hundred sixty-two
18 dollars and fifty cents.

19 (3) Academic year tuition for full-time students at the state's
20 institutions of higher education beginning with the 1996-97 academic
21 year, other than the summer term, shall be as provided in this
22 subsection.

23 (a) At the University of Washington and Washington State
24 University:

25 (i) For resident undergraduate students and other resident students
26 not in graduate study programs or enrolled in programs leading to the
27 degrees of doctor of medicine, doctor of dental surgery, and doctor of
28 veterinary medicine, two thousand eight hundred seventy-five dollars;

29 (ii) For nonresident undergraduate students and other nonresident
30 students not in graduate study programs or enrolled in programs leading
31 to the degrees of doctor of medicine, doctor of dental surgery, and
32 doctor of veterinary medicine, (~~eight thousand five hundred ninety-~~
33 ~~nine~~) nine thousand four hundred ninety-one dollars;

34 (iii) For resident graduate and law students not enrolled in
35 programs leading to the degrees of doctor of medicine, doctor of dental
36 surgery, and doctor of veterinary medicine, four thousand six hundred
37 sixty-nine dollars;

38 (iv) For nonresident graduate and law students not enrolled in
39 programs leading to the degrees of doctor of medicine, doctor of dental

1 surgery, and doctor of veterinary medicine, twelve thousand one hundred
2 dollars;

3 (v) For resident students enrolled in programs leading to the
4 degrees of doctor of medicine, doctor of dental surgery, and doctor of
5 veterinary medicine, seven thousand seven hundred ninety-seven dollars;
6 and

7 (vi) For nonresident students enrolled in programs leading to the
8 degrees of doctor of medicine, doctor of dental surgery, and doctor of
9 veterinary medicine, twenty thousand two hundred nine dollars.

10 (b) At the regional universities and The Evergreen State College:

11 (i) For resident undergraduate and all other resident students not
12 in graduate study programs, two thousand one hundred twenty-seven
13 dollars;

14 (ii) For nonresident undergraduate and all other nonresident
15 students not in graduate study programs, eight thousand three hundred
16 twelve dollars;

17 (iii) For resident graduate students, three thousand five hundred
18 eighty-one dollars; and

19 (iv) For nonresident graduate students, eleven thousand five
20 hundred fourteen dollars.

21 (c) At the community colleges:

22 (i) For resident students, one thousand two hundred sixty-one
23 dollars; and

24 (ii) For nonresident students, five thousand three hundred sixty-
25 nine dollars and fifty cents.

26 (4) The tuition fees established under this chapter shall not apply
27 to high school students enrolling in community colleges under RCW
28 28A.600.300 through 28A.600.395.

29 NEW SECTION. **Sec. 2.** If any provision of this act or its
30 application to any person or circumstance is held invalid, the
31 remainder of the act or the application of the provision to other
32 persons or circumstances is not affected."
