**Background:** The state government operates on the basis of a fiscal biennium that begins on July 1 of each odd-numbered year.

**Summary of Substitute Bill:** The 1995-97 omnibus appropriations act.

**Substitute Bill Compared to Original Bill:** The substitute bill makes appropriations for the 1995-97 biennium. The state general fund total is \$17.3 billion.

**Appropriation:** None.

**Fiscal Note:** Not requested.

**Effective Date of Substitute Bill:** The bill contains an emergency clause and takes effect on July 1, 1995.
