- 1 TO THE PRESIDENT OF THE SENATE AND THE SPEAKER OF THE HOUSE OF
- 2 REPRESENTATIVES, AND TO THE SENATE AND HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES OF THE
- 3 UNITED STATES, IN CONGRESS ASSEMBLED:
- 4 We, your Memorialists, the Senate and House of Representatives of
- 5 the State of Washington, in legislative session assembled, respectfully
- 6 represent and petition as follows:
- 7 WHEREAS, With each passing year this Nation becomes deeply in debt
- 8 as its expenditures grossly and repeatedly exceed available revenues so
- 9 that the public debt now exceeds three trillion dollars; and
- 10 WHEREAS, Attempts to limit spending, including impoundment of funds
- 11 by the President of the United States, have resulted in strenuous
- 12 assertions that the responsibility for appropriations is the
- 13 constitutional duty of the Congress; and
- 14 WHEREAS, The annual Federal budget repeatedly demonstrates the
- 15 unwillingness or inability of both the legislative and executive
- 16 branches of the Federal government to curtail spending to conform to
- 17 available revenues; and
- 18 WHEREAS, The unified budget does not reflect actual spending
- 19 because of the exclusion of special outlays that are not in the budget;

1 WHEREAS, Knowledgeable planning and fiscal prudence require that 2 the budget reflect all Federal spending and that the budget be in 3 balance; and

WHEREAS, Believing that fiscal irresponsibility at the Federal level is one of the greatest economic threats that faces our Nation, we firmly believe that constitutional restraint is necessary to bring the fiscal discipline needed to reverse this trend;

NOW, THEREFORE, Your Memorialists, a majority of all members of the two houses, voting separately, concurring herein, petition the Congress of the United States of America to adopt an amendment to the Constitution of the United States, for submission to the states for ratification, requiring, with certain exceptions, that for each fiscal year the President of the United States submit and the Congress of the United States adopt a balanced federal budget.

BE IT RESOLVED, That copies of this Memorial be immediately transmitted to the President of the United States Senate, the Speaker of the House of Representatives, to each member of Congress from the State of Washington, and to the presiding officer of each house of each state legislature in the United States.
