## HOUSE JOINT RESOLUTION 4219

BE IT RESOLVED, BY THE SENATE AND HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES OF THE STATE OF WASHINGTON, IN LEGISLATIVE SESSION ASSEMBLED:

3 THAT, At the next general election to be held in this state there 4 shall be submitted to the qualified voters of the state for their 5 approval and ratification, or rejection, an amendment to Article VII of 6 the Constitution of the state of Washington by adding a new section to 7 read as follows:

Article VII, section . . . Nothing in this Article VII as amended 9 shall prevent the legislature from providing, by appropriate 10 legislation, property tax relief by setting base years for property tax 11 valuation computation, limiting property tax valuation increases to two 12 percent per year over the base year until ownership of the property 13 changes, and limiting the tax assessed on owner-occupied property 14 claimed as a principal place of residence.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, That the secretary of state shall cause notice of the foregoing constitutional amendment to be published at least four times during the four weeks next preceding the election in every legal newspaper in the state.
