1            AN ACT Relating to exemptions from industrial insurance coverage  
2 for persons under age twenty-one employed on the family farm; and  
3 adding a new section to chapter 51.12 RCW.

4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF WASHINGTON:

5            NEW SECTION.    **Sec. 1.** A new section is added to chapter 51.12 RCW  
6 to read as follows:

7            (1) The parent or parents of a person at least eighteen years of  
8 age but under twenty-one years of age may elect to exclude from  
9 mandatory coverage under this title the parent's employment of that  
10 person in agricultural activities on their family farm if:

11            (a) The person resides with his or her parent or parents or resides  
12 on their family farm; and

13            (b) The parent or parents file a written notice with the department  
14 electing exclusion from coverage.

15            (2) A parent or parents who have elected to exclude a person under  
16 this subsection may subsequently obtain coverage for that person under  
17 RCW 51.12.110.

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
