1       AN ACT Relating to extending terminal safety audit fees to vehicles  
2 operating under the International Registration Plan; amending RCW  
3 46.32.090; and providing an effective date.

4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF WASHINGTON:

5       **Sec. 1.** RCW 46.32.090 and 1995 c 272 s 2 are each amended to read  
6 as follows:

7       The department shall collect a fee of ten dollars, in addition to  
8 all other fees and taxes, for each motor vehicle base plated in the  
9 state of Washington that is subject to highway inspections and terminal  
10 audits under RCW 46.32.080, at the time of registration and renewal of  
11 registration under chapter 46.16 or 46.87 RCW, or the International  
12 Registration Plan if based plated in a foreign jurisdiction. The ten-  
13 dollar fee must be apportioned for those vehicles operating interstate  
14 and registered under the International Registration Plan. This fee  
15 does not apply to nonmotor powered vehicles, including trailers.  
16 Refunds will not be provided for fees paid under this section when the  
17 vehicle is no longer subject to RCW 46.32.080. The department may  
18 deduct an amount equal to the cost of administering the program. All

1 remaining fees shall be deposited with the state treasurer and credited  
2 to the state patrol highway account of the motor vehicle fund.

3 NEW SECTION. **Sec. 2.** Section 1 of this act becomes effective with  
4 motor vehicle registration fees due or to become due January 1, 1997.

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
