- 1 AN ACT Relating to attachments to transmission facilities; adding
- 2 a new section to chapter 80.54 RCW; and adding a new chapter to Title
- 3 54 RCW.
- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF WASHINGTON:
- 5 <u>NEW SECTION.</u> **Sec. 1.** Unless the context clearly requires
- 6 otherwise, the definitions in this section apply throughout this
- 7 chapter.
- 8 (1) "Attachment" means the affixation or installation of any wire,
- 9 cable, or other physical material capable of carrying electronic
- 10 impulses for the carrying of intelligence for telecommunications or
- 11 television, including, but not limited to cable, and any related
- 12 device, apparatus, or auxiliary equipment upon any pole or in any
- 13 telecommunications, electrical, cable television, or communications
- 14 right of way duct, conduit, or other similar facilities owned or
- 15 controlled in whole or in part by one or more locally regulated
- 16 utilities when the installation has been made with the consent of one
- 17 or more such utilities.
- 18 (2) "Locally regulated utility" means any utility not regulated by
- 19 the utilities and transportation commission.

- 1 <u>NEW SECTION.</u> **Sec. 2.** (1) All rates, terms, and conditions made,
- 2 demanded, or received by a locally regulated utility for attachments to
- 3 its facilities must be just, fair, equitable, nondiscriminatory, and
- 4 sufficient.
- 5 (2) A just and reasonable rate must assure the locally regulated
- 6 utility the recovery of not less than the make-ready costs, which
- 7 consist of all the additional costs of procuring and maintaining
- 8 attachments, and the allowable space rental cost, which shall not
- 9 exceed the actual capital and operating expenses and right of way costs
- 10 of the locally regulated utility attributable to that portion of the
- 11 pole, duct, or conduit used for the attachment as compared to all other
- 12 uses made of the subject facilities and uses that remain available to
- 13 the owner or owners of the subject facilities, and including a share of
- 14 the required support and clearance space.
- 15 (3) A locally regulated utility shall levy attachment space rental
- 16 rates that are uniform for the same class of service provided within
- 17 the service area of the locally regulated utility.
- 18 <u>NEW SECTION.</u> **Sec. 3.** Any party seeking attachment as defined by
- 19 section 1 of this act shall be liable for any damages incurred by the
- 20 owner of a pole, conduit, duct, vault, or other similar facilities, and
- 21 for any damages to other facilities which are co-located on such pole,
- 22 conduit, duct, vault, or other similar facilities as a result of the
- 23 installation or maintenance of attachments. A locally regulated
- 24 utility may reserve space for system reliability purposes.
- NEW SECTION. Sec. 4. A new section is added to chapter 80.54 RCW
- 26 to read as follows:
- The commission shall not regulate activities covered under chapter
- 28 54.-- RCW (sections 1 through 3 of this act).
- 29 <u>NEW SECTION.</u> **Sec. 5.** Sections 1 through 3 of this act shall
- 30 constitute a new chapter in Title 54 RCW.
