State of Washington 54th Legislature 1995 2nd Special Session

1 WHEREAS, It is of paramount importance to establish limitations on
2 the consideration of legislation during the 1995 second special session
3 of the Fifty-fourth Legislature;

4 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, By the Washington State Senate,
5 with the House of Representatives concurring, that for the duration of
6 the 1995 second special session of the Legislature, neither house may
7 consider any bills, memorials, or joint resolutions except budgets,
8 matters necessary to implement budgets, revenue measures, and matters
9 incident to the interim and to the closing of the business of the 1995
10 second special session of the Legislature, and that after 5:00 p.m.
11 Thursday, May 25th, only matters incident to the interim and to the
12 closing of the business of the 1995 second special session of the
13 Legislature may be considered.
