1 TO THE HONORABLE BILL CLINTON, PRESIDENT OF THE UNITED STATES, AND
2 TO THE PRESIDENT OF THE SENATE AND THE SPEAKER OF THE HOUSE OF
3 REPRESENTATIVES, AND TO THE SENATE AND HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES OF THE
4 UNITED STATES, IN CONGRESS ASSEMBLED:

5 We, your Memorialists, the Senate and House of Representatives of
6 the State of Washington, in legislative session assembled, respectfully
7 represent and petition as follows:

8 WHEREAS, Taiwan, Republic of China, has been a strong trading
9 partner of the United States and of the State of Washington, with over
10 seven and one-half billion dollars in trade between Taiwan and the
11 State of Washington annually; and

12 WHEREAS, Taiwan, Republic of China, desires admission to the United
13 Nations as a member nation; and

14 WHEREAS, The inclusion of Taiwan in the United Nations is in
15 keeping with the United Nation's principle of universality and will
16 contribute to global cooperation in fields such as economic development
17 and environmental and ecological protection. It will also help promote
18 international assistance programs by the United Nations related
19 agencies to the developing countries;

1 NOW, THEREFORE, Your Memorialists respectfully pray that the United
2 States advocate before the United Nations for the admission of Taiwan
3 as a member nation.

4 BE IT RESOLVED, That copies of this Memorial be immediately
5 transmitted to the Honorable Bill Clinton, President of the United
6 States, the President of the United States Senate, the Speaker of the
7 House of Representatives, and each member of Congress from the State of
8 Washington.
