3 On page 1, after line 3, insert the following section:

4 **Sec. 1.** RCW 43.101.030 and 1981 chapter 132 s 3 are each
5 amended to read as follows:

6 The commission shall consist of (~~twelve~~) fourteen members, who
7 shall be selected as follows:

8 (1) The governor shall appoint two incumbent sheriffs and two
9 incumbent chiefs of police.

10 (2) The governor shall appoint one person employed in a county
11 correctional system and one person employed in the state
12 correctional system.

13 (3) The governor shall appoint one incumbent county
14 prosecuting attorney or municipal attorney.

15 (4) The governor shall appoint one elected official of a local
16 government.

17 (5) The governor shall appoint one private citizen.

18 (6) The governor shall appoint two peace officers representing
19 local law enforcement agencies. The appointments must be from a
20 list submitted by the Washington State Council of Police Officers.

21 (~~(6)~~) (7) The three remaining members shall be:

22 (a) The attorney general;

23 (b) The special agent in charge of the Seattle office of the
24 federal bureau of investigation; and

25 (c) The chief of the state patrol.-

26 RENUMBER REMAINING SECTIONS CONSECUTIVELY, CORRECT INTERNAL
27 REFERENCES ACCORDINGLY AND CORRECT THE TITLE ACCORDINGLY.

EFFECT: The membership on the Criminal Justice Training
Commission is increased by two positions. The two positions
must be local law enforcement officers to be appointed by the
governor from a list submitted by the Washington State Council
of Police Officers.
