EFFECT: To establish a pattern of criminal gang activity, both of the offenses must be committed after the effective date of this act, rather than just one and must be committed on separate occasions. Before a principal must consider long term suspension or expulsion as a sanction for a student who violates various provisions of the act two or more times, both violations must occur after the effective date of this act.
