5 Strike everything after the enacting clause and insert the  
6 following:

7 "NEW SECTION. **Sec. 1.** The legislature finds that consistent with  
8 the goal of growth management that public services and facilities  
9 necessary to support development be available without a decrease in  
10 service levels, citizens should have the opportunity to decide whether  
11 all land in a planned community which includes industrial, commercial,  
12 and residential sites will be in the same school district.

13 NEW SECTION. **Sec. 2.** Notwithstanding the provisions of RCW  
14 28A.315.250, the school board of a school district that includes a  
15 military reservation and portions of a city or town with a population  
16 of less than three thousand that includes territory located in two  
17 school districts may call a special election to be held at which voters  
18 authorize the removal of the city or town and its planned community  
19 from one school district and the transfer of that portion of the city  
20 or town and its planned community to the other school district, under  
21 the following conditions: (1) One of the two school districts either  
22 borders a United States military reservation or includes territory  
23 located in a United States military reservation; and (2) a public  
24 school building is not located in the territory that is so removed and  
25 transferred.

26 The special election shall be held at a special election date  
27 specified under RCW 29.13.020 at which a ballot proposition authorizing  
28 the removal and transfer of the portion of the city or town and its  
29 planned community from one school district to the other school district  
30 is submitted to the voters of the school district that includes a  
31 military reservation and portions of the city or town with a population  
32 of less than three thousand. If the ballot proposition is approved by  
33 a simple majority vote of voters of the school district voting on the  
34 ballot proposition, the educational service district superintendent  
35 within which the school districts are located shall make an order so

1 altering the boundaries of the school districts. The cost of the  
2 election must be paid by the school district calling the special  
3 election.

4 This section expires January 1, 1999.

5 NEW SECTION. **Sec. 3.** This act is necessary for the immediate  
6 preservation of the public peace, health, or safety, or support of the  
7 state government and its existing public institutions, and takes effect  
8 immediately."
