7 NEW SECTION. Sec. 25. A new section is added to chapter 41.56
8 RCW to read as follows:

9 This chapter applies to charter schools as defined in section
10 4 of this act and to the charter schools' employees in the
11 bargaining unit. The bargaining unit of employees of charter
12 schools must be limited to the employees of the charter schools and
13 must be separate from other bargaining units within the sponsoring
14 or alternative sponsoring organization unless the charter school
15 board of directors and the exclusive bargaining representative of
16 the charter school employees agree to include the charter school
17 employees in an appropriate bargaining unit represented by the same
18 employee organization in the school district in which the charter
19 school is located.

20 NEW SECTION. Sec. 26. A new section is added to chapter 41.59
21 RCW to read as follows:

22 This chapter applies to charter schools as defined in section
23 4 of this act and to the charter schools' employees in the
24 bargaining unit. The bargaining unit of employees of charter
25 schools must be limited to the employees of the charter schools and
26 must be separate from other bargaining units within the sponsoring
27 or alternative sponsoring organization unless the charter school
28 board of directors and the exclusive bargaining representative of
29 the charter school employees agree to include the charter school
30 employees in an appropriate bargaining unit represented by the same

1 employee organization in the school district in which the charter
2 school is located."

3 Renumber the sections consecutively and correct internal references
4 accordingly.

EFFECT: The underlying amendment allows employees of charter schools to join a collective bargaining unit limited to the charter school employees or to join a district-wide unit. The amendment to the amendment provides that the bargaining unit *must* be limited to the charter school employees unless the board of directors of the charter school and the bargaining representative of the employees agree that the bargaining unit may be district-wide.
