8 NEW SECTION. **Sec. 6.** In order to provide service to  
9 developers of projects of state-wide significance, the department  
10 shall charge reasonable fees for services under this chapter. The  
11 fees must be based on a percentage of the cost of the eligible  
12 project and are not intended to exceed the costs of providing the  
13 service. The fees may not be paid from funds from a federal,  
14 state, or local government source.

15 NEW SECTION. **Sec. 7.** The ombudsman fee account is created in  
16 the state treasury. The account consists of all receipts from fees  
17 charged by the department under section 6 of this act.  
18 Expenditures from the account may be used only for purposes of this  
19 chapter. Only the director or the director's designee may  
20 authorize expenditures from the account. Expenditures from the  
21 account may be spent only after appropriation.-

22 Renumber the remaining sections consecutively and correct internal  
23 references accordingly.

**EFFECT:** Makes the local government mandatory notification  
voluntary. Allows the department to charge a fee for the  
ombudsman service for projects of state-wide significance.
