3 On page 6, line 1 of the striking amendment, strike subsection
4 (9)- insert subsections (9) and (10)-

5 On page 6, after line 31 of the striking amendment, insert the
6 following:

7 (10) The public stadium authority shall retain one and three-
8 quarters percent of all revenues derived from the operations of the
9 stadium and exhibition center to be divided as follows: (a) fourteen
10 percent to be used to pay for local improvements within the areas
11 surrounding the stadium and exhibition center, (b) fourteen percent to
12 be deposited into the youth play field grant account created in section
13 217(4) of this act, (c) thirty-one percent shall be deposited into the
14 stadium and exhibition center account created in section 217(1) of this
15 act, (d) fourteen percent may be distributed to a nonprofit
16 organization to be used to support the special Olympics in the state of
17 Washington, and (e) thirty-one percent shall be used for statewide
18 tourism development and promotion activities of the department of
19 community, trade, and economic development;-

20 Renumber the remaining subsections consecutively and correct internal
21 references accordingly.

22 On page 21, line 10 of the striking amendment, after under-
23 insert section 106(10) of this act and-

EFFECT: Dedicates 1.75 percent of stadium revenues to be used as follows: 14 percent each for local improvements in the area, statewide funding of youth sports fields, and Special Olympics; and 31 percent each for stadium bond debt repayment and tourism promotion.
