3 On page 22, beginning on line 1 of the striking amendment, strike  
4 youth athletic facility account- and insert play field and activity  
5 center account-

6 On page 22, line 8 of the striking amendment, strike youth  
7 athletic facility account- and insert play field and activity center  
8 account-

9 On page 22, beginning on line 12 of the striking amendment, strike  
10 all of subsection (4) and insert the following:

11 (4) Any unappropriated moneys in the stadium and exhibition  
12 center account not required or permitted to be used for the purposes  
13 described in subsection (3)(a) and (b) of this section shall be  
14 deposited in the play field and activity center account hereby created  
15 in the custody of the state treasurer. Only the state treasurer or the  
16 treasurer's designee may authorize expenditures from the account. The  
17 account is subject to the allotment procedures under chapter 43.88 RCW,  
18 but an appropriation is not required for expenditure. Expenditures  
19 from the account may be used only for the purposes set forth in (b) of  
20 this subsection (4).

21 (b) (i) The treasurer shall annually distribute moneys in the play  
22 field and activity center account to each eligible county on a per-  
23 capita basis.

24 (ii) A county is eligible to receive a distribution under this  
25 subsection (4) if it has established a play field and activity center  
26 committee. The committee consists of one member of the county  
27 legislative body and one member from the city council of each city  
28 located wholly or partially within the county.

29 (iii) Moneys distributed to eligible counties under this  
30 subsection (4) may be expended upon authorization of the county's play  
31 field and activity center committee. Expenditures may be used only for  
32 acquiring, developing, equipping, maintaining, or improving play fields  
33 and activity centers. For purposes of this subsection (4), activity  
34 center- includes but is not limited to youth centers and senior

1 centers. Moneys distributed to counties under this subsection (4) may  
2 be used by counties for construction of a minor league baseball  
3 stadium.-

**EFFECT:** Moneys in excess of the debt service and reserves in the stadium and exhibition center account must be transferred to the play field and activity center account. Rather than being distributed by the Interagency Committee for Outdoor Recreation to cities and counties as competitive grants, the moneys will be distributed by the Treasurer on a per capita basis to counties that have established committees consisting of representatives from county and city legislative bodies. Counties may use the money for expenditures related to play fields and activity centers, including youth and senior centers, and counties may use the money for construction of a minor league baseball stadium.
