20 state government and its existing public institutions, and takes effect
21 immediately.-

EFFECT: Adds \$10 million to the 1997-99 Capital Budget, including \$4.7 million for housing programs, \$700,000 for the community services facilities program, and \$4.6 million for Heritage Park. Transfers the appropriation for public participation grants under the Model Toxics Control Act from the Department of Community, Trade, and Economic Development to the Department of Ecology.
