- 8 For the purpose of and as used in this chapter:
- 9 (1) "Court" means the superior court of the state of Washington, 10 juvenile department.
- 11 (2) "Law enforcement agency" means the police department, the 12 prosecuting attorney, the state patrol, the director of public safety, 13 or the office of the sheriff.
- (3) "Practitioner of the healing arts" or "practitioner" means a 14 15 person licensed by this state to practice podiatric medicine and surgery, optometry, chiropractic, nursing, dentistry, osteopathic 16 medicine and surgery, or medicine and surgery or to provide other 17 The term "practitioner" shall include a duly 18 health services. 19 accredited Christian Science practitioner: PROVIDED, HOWEVER, That a 20 person who is being furnished Christian Science treatment by a duly accredited Christian Science practitioner shall not be considered, for 21 22 that reason alone, a neglected person for the purposes of this chapter.
- 23 (4) "Institution" means a private or public hospital or any other 24 facility providing medical diagnosis, treatment or care.
- 25 (5) "Department" means the state department of social and health 26 services.
- 27 (6) "Child" or "children" means any person under the age of 28 eighteen years of age.
- 29 (7) "Professional school personnel" shall include, but not be 30 limited to, teachers, counselors, administrators, child care facility 31 personnel, and school nurses.
- 32 (8) "Social service counselor" shall mean anyone engaged in a 33 professional capacity during the regular course of employment in 34 encouraging or promoting the health, welfare, support or education of 35 children, or providing social services to adults or families, including 36 mental health, drug and alcohol treatment, and domestic violence

- 1 programs, whether in an individual capacity, or as an employee or agent 2 of any public or private organization or institution.
- 3 (9) "Psychologist" shall mean any person licensed to practice 4 psychology under chapter 18.83 RCW, whether acting in an individual 5 capacity or as an employee or agent of any public or private 6 organization or institution.
- 7 (10) "Pharmacist" shall mean any registered pharmacist under the 8 provisions of chapter 18.64 RCW, whether acting in an individual 9 capacity or as an employee or agent of any public or private 10 organization or institution.
- 11 (11) "Clergy" shall mean any regularly licensed or ordained 12 minister, priest or rabbi of any church or religious denomination, 13 whether acting in an individual capacity or as an employee or agent of 14 any public or private organization or institution.
- 15 (12) "Abuse or neglect" shall mean the injury, sexual abuse, sexual
  16 exploitation, negligent treatment, or maltreatment of a child, adult
  17 dependent, or developmentally disabled person by any person under
  18 circumstances which indicate that the child's or adult's health,
  19 welfare, and safety is harmed. An abused child is a child who has been
  20 subjected to child abuse or neglect as defined herein.
- 21 (13) "Child protective services section" shall mean the child 22 protective services section of the department.
- 23 (14) "Adult dependent persons" shall be defined as those persons 24 over the age of eighteen years who have been found to be legally 25 incompetent or disabled pursuant to chapter 11.88 RCW.
- (15) "Sexual exploitation" includes: (a) Allowing, permitting, or encouraging a child to engage in prostitution by any person; or (b) allowing, permitting, encouraging, or engaging in the obscene or pornographic photographing, filming, or depicting of a child by any person.
- (16) "Negligent treatment or maltreatment" means an act or omission which evidences a serious disregard of consequences of such magnitude as to constitute a clear and present danger to the child's health, welfare, and safety.
- 35 (17) "Developmentally disabled person" means a person who has a 36 disability defined in RCW 71A.10.020.
- 37 (18) "Child protective services" means those services provided by 38 the department designed to protect children from child abuse and 39 neglect and safeguard the general welfare of such children and shall

- 1 include investigations of child abuse and neglect reports, including
- 2 reports regarding child care centers and family child care homes, and
- 3 the development, management, and provision of or referral to services
- 4 to ameliorate conditions which endanger the welfare of children, the
- 5 coordination of necessary programs and services relevant to the
- 6 prevention, intervention, and treatment of child abuse and neglect, and
- 7 services to children to ensure that each child has a permanent home.
- 8 In determining whether protective services should be provided, the
- 9 department shall not decline to provide such services solely because of
- 10 the child's unwillingness or developmental inability to describe the
- 11 nature and severity of the abuse or neglect.
- 12 (19) "Malice" or "maliciously" means an evil intent, wish, or
- 13 design to vex, annoy, or injure another person. Such malice may be
- 14 inferred from an act done in wilful disregard of the rights of another,
- 15 or an act wrongfully done without just cause or excuse, or an act or
- 16 omission of duty betraying a wilful disregard of social duty.
- 17 (20) "Sexually aggressive youth" means a child who is defined in
- 18 RCW 74.13.075(1)(b) as being a "sexually aggressive youth."
- 19 (21) "Information determined to be unfounded" means information
- 20 related to the allegations in a child protective services referral for
- 21 which there is reasonable cause for the social worker to believe, based
- 22 on a child protective services investigation, that the allegations are
- 23 <u>untrue or that sufficient evidence exists to reasonably conclude that</u>
- 24 the child has not been abused or neglected nor is at risk of abuse or
- 25 <u>neglect.</u>"
- 26 Correct the title.
- 27 <u>EFFECT:</u> Adds the department's definition of "unfounded" to 28 statute.
