17 **Sec. 720.** RCW 43.98A.070 and 1990 1st ex.s. c 14 s 7 are
18 each amended to read as follows:

19 (1) In determining which state parks proposals and local parks
20 proposals to fund, the committee shall use existing policies and
21 priorities.

22 (2) Moneys appropriated for this chapter may not be used by
23 the committee to fund additional staff or other overhead expenses,
24 or by a state, regional, or local agency to fund operation and
25 maintenance of areas acquired under this chapter, except that the
26 committee may use moneys appropriated for this chapter for the
27 fiscal biennium ending June 30, 1999, for the administrative costs
28 of implementing the pilot watershed plan implementation program and
29 developing an inventory of publicly-owned lands.

1 (3) Moneys appropriated for this chapter may be used for costs
2 incidental to acquisition, including, but not limited to, surveying
3 expenses, fencing, and signing.

4 (4) The committee may not approve a project of a local agency
5 where the share contributed by the local agency is less than the
6 amount to be awarded from the outdoor recreation account.

7 (5) The committee may adopt rules establishing acquisition
8 policies and priorities for the acquisition and development of
9 trails and water access sites to be financed from moneys in the
10 outdoor recreation account.

11 (6) In determining the acquisition and development priorities,
12 the committee shall consider, at a minimum, the following criteria:

13 (a) For trails proposals:

14 (i) Community support;

15 (ii) Immediacy of threat to the site;

16 (iii) Linkage between communities;

17 (iv) Linkage between trails;

18 (v) Existing or potential usage;

19 (vi) Consistency with an existing local land use plan or a
20 regional or state-wide recreational or resource plan;

21 (vii) Availability of water access or views;

22 (viii) Enhancement of wildlife habitat; and

23 (ix) Scenic values of the site.

24 (b) For water access proposals:

25 (i) Community support;

26 (ii) Distance from similar water access opportunities;

27 (iii) Immediacy of threat to the site;

28 (iv) Diversity of possible recreational uses; and

29 (v) Public demand in the area.

30 (7) Before October 1st of each even-numbered year, the
31 committee shall recommend to the governor a prioritized list of
32 state agency projects to be funded under RCW 43.98A.050(1) (a),
33 (c), and (d). The governor may remove projects from the list
34 recommended by the committee and shall submit this amended list in
35 the capital budget request to the legislature. The list shall
36 include, but not be limited to, a description of each project; and
37 shall describe for each project any anticipated restrictions upon
38 recreational activities allowed prior to the project.

1 (8) Before October 1st of each year, the committee shall
2 recommend to the governor a prioritized list of all local projects
3 to be funded under RCW 43.98A.050(1) (b), (c), and (d) of this act.
4 The governor may remove projects from the list recommended by the
5 committee and shall submit this amended list in the capital budget
6 request to the legislature. The list shall include, but not be
7 limited to, a description of each project and any particular match
8 requirement, and describe for each project any anticipated
9 restrictions upon recreational activities allowed prior to the
10 project.-

11 Renumber the remaining sections consecutively, correct
12 internal references accordingly, and correct the title.

EFFECT: Makes a technical correction to account references.
Permits the Interagency Committee for Outdoor Recreation to
use WWRP appropriations for the administrative costs of
developing an inventory of publicly-owned lands and
implementing the pilot watershed plan implementation program.
