7 "Sec. 1. RCW 10.05.150 and 1985 c 352 s 17 are each amended to  
8 read as follows:

9 A deferred prosecution program for alcoholism shall be for a two-  
10 year period and shall include, but not be limited to, the following  
11 requirements:

12 (1) Total abstinence from alcohol and all other nonprescribed mind-  
13 altering drugs;

14 (2) Participation in an intensive inpatient or intensive outpatient  
15 program in a state-approved alcoholism treatment (~~(facility))~~ program;

16 (3) Participation in a minimum of two meetings per week of an  
17 alcoholism self-help recovery support group, as determined by the  
18 assessing agency, for the duration of the treatment program;

19 (4) Participation in an alcoholism self-help recovery support  
20 group, as determined by the assessing agency, from the date of court  
21 approval of the plan to entry into intensive treatment;

22 (5) Operation of a motor vehicle only if equipped with a  
23 functioning ignition interlock or other biological device as authorized  
24 by RCW 46.20.720 and only with a driver's license imprinted with a  
25 notation as required by RCW 46.20.740. The court may waive the  
26 requirement for the use of such a device if the court makes a specific  
27 finding in writing that such devices are not reasonably available in  
28 the local area;

29 (6) Not less than weekly approved outpatient counseling, group or  
30 individual, for a minimum of six months following the intensive phase  
31 of treatment;

32 (~~(+6))~~ (7) Not less than monthly outpatient contact, group or  
33 individual, for the remainder of the two-year deferred prosecution  
34 period;

1       (~~(7)~~) (8) The decision to include the use of prescribed drugs,  
2 including disulfiram, as a condition of treatment shall be reserved to  
3 the treating facility and the petitioner's physician;

4       (~~(8)~~) (9) All treatment within the purview of this section shall  
5 occur within or be approved by a state-approved alcoholism \*treatment  
6 facility as described in chapter 70.96A RCW;

7       (~~(9)~~) (10) Signature of the petitioner agreeing to the terms and  
8 conditions of the treatment program.

9       NEW SECTION.   **Sec. 2.**   This act takes effect January 1, 1999."
