- 8 No person may file an application for ((an occupational)) a
- 9 temporary restricted driver's license as provided in RCW 46.20.391
- 10 unless he or she first pays to the director or other person authorized
- 11 to accept applications and fees for driver's licenses a fee of twenty-
- 12 five dollars. The applicant shall receive upon payment an official
- 13 receipt for the payment of such fee. All such fees shall be forwarded
- 14 to the director who shall transmit such fees to the state treasurer in
- 15 the same manner as other driver's license fees.
- 16 **Sec. 7.** RCW 46.20.391 and 1995 c 332 s 12 are each amended to read 17 as follows:
- 18 (1) Any person licensed under this chapter who is convicted of an
- 19 offense relating to motor vehicles for which suspension or revocation
- 20 of the driver's license is mandatory, other than vehicular homicide or
- 21 vehicular assault, may submit to the department an application for ((an
- 22 occupational)) a temporary restricted driver's license. The
- 23 department, upon receipt of the prescribed fee and upon determining
- 24 that the petitioner is ((engaged in an occupation or trade that makes
- 25 it essential that the petitioner operate a motor vehicle)) eliqible to
- 26 receive the license under subsection (3) of this section, may issue
- 27 ((an occupational)) a temporary restricted driver's license and may set
- 28 definite restrictions as provided in RCW 46.20.394. No person may
- 29 petition for, and the department shall not issue, ((an occupational))
- 30 a temporary restricted driver's license that is effective during the
- 31 first thirty days of any suspension or revocation imposed for a
- 32 violation of RCW 46.61.502 or 46.61.504.
- 33 (2) A person aggrieved by the decision of the department on the
- 34 application for ((an occupational)) a temporary restricted driver's
- 35 license may request a hearing as provided by rule of the department.

- 1  $((\frac{2}{2}))$  <u>(3)</u> An applicant for  $(\frac{2}{2})$  a temporary 2 restricted driver's license is eligible to receive such license only 3 if:
- 4 (a) Within one year immediately preceding the date of the offense 5 that gave rise to the present conviction, the applicant has not 6 committed any offense relating to motor vehicles for which suspension 7 or revocation of a driver's license is mandatory; and
- 8 (b) Within five years immediately preceding the date of the offense 9 that gave rise to the present conviction, the applicant has not committed any of the following offenses: (i) Driving or being in actual physical control of a motor vehicle while under the influence of intoxicating liquor; (ii) vehicular homicide under RCW 46.61.520; or (iii) vehicular assault under RCW 46.61.522; and
- 14 (c) The applicant meets at least one of the following qualifying 15 circumstances: (i) Is engaged in an occupation or trade that makes it 16 essential that he or she operate a motor vehicle; (ii) is undergoing continuing health care or providing continuing health care to another 17 18 who is dependent upon the applicant; (iii) is enrolled in an 19 educational institution and pursuing a course of study leading to a diploma, degree, or other certification of successful educational 20 completion; (iv) is undergoing substance abuse treatment; (v) is 21 fulfilling court-ordered community service responsibilities; or (vi) is 22 23 in an apprenticeship, on-the-job training, or welfare-to-work program; 24 and
- 25 (d) The applicant files satisfactory proof of financial 26 responsibility pursuant to chapter 46.29 RCW.
- $((\frac{3}{1}))$  (4) The director shall cancel  $(\frac{an \ occupational}{a})$  a 27 28 temporary restricted driver's license upon receipt of notice that the 29 holder thereof has been convicted of operating a motor vehicle in 30 violation of its restrictions, or of an offense that pursuant to 31 chapter 46.20 RCW would warrant suspension or revocation of a regular driver's license. The cancellation is effective as of the date of the 32 conviction, and continues with the same force and effect as any 33 suspension or revocation under this title. 34
- 35 **Sec. 8.** RCW 46.20.394 and 1983 c 165 s 26 are each amended to read as follows:
- In issuing ((an occupational)) a temporary restricted driver's license under RCW 46.20.391, the department shall describe the ((type

of occupation permitted)) qualifying circumstances and shall set forth 1 in detail the specific hours of the day during which the person may 2 drive to and from his ((place of work)) or her home, which may not 3 4 exceed twelve hours in any one day; the days of the week during which the license may be used; and the general routes over which the person 5 may travel. These restrictions shall be prepared in written form by 6 the department, which document shall be carried in the vehicle at all 7 8 times and presented to a law enforcement officer under the same terms 9 as the ((<del>occupational</del>)) <u>temporary restricted</u> driver's license. violation of the restrictions constitutes a violation of RCW 46.20.342 10 and subjects the person to all procedures and penalties therefor. 11

12 **Sec. 9.** RCW 46.20.400 and 1967 c 32 s 33 are each amended to read 13 as follows:

If ((an occupational)) a temporary restricted driver's license is 14 issued and is not revoked during the period for which issued the 15 licensee may obtain a new driver's license at the end of such period, 16 but no new driver's ((permit shall)) license may be issued to such 17 18 person until he or she surrenders his ((occupational)) or her temporary restricted driver's license and his or her copy of the order and the 19 director is satisfied that he or she complies with all other provisions 20 of law relative to the issuance of a driver's license." 21
