- 7 "NEW SECTION. Sec. 1. It is the intent of the legislature to
- 8 ensure agencies assess the impact of proposed rules on family well-
- 9 being and to improve the management of executive branch agencies.
- 10 <u>NEW SECTION.</u> **Sec. 2.** A new section is added to chapter 34.05 RCW
- 11 to read as follows:
- 12 For purposes of sections 1, 3, 4, and 5 of this act, the term
- 13 "family" means:
- 14 (1) A group of individuals related by blood, marriage, or adoption
- 15 who live together as a single household; and
- 16 (2) Any individual who is not a member of such group, but who is
- 17 related by blood, marriage, or adoption to a member of such group, and
- 18 over half of whose support in a calendar year is received from such
- 19 group.
- 20 <u>NEW SECTION.</u> **Sec. 3.** A new section is added to chapter 34.05 RCW
- 21 to read as follows:
- 22 Upon request by a member of the legislature, an agency shall
- 23 prepare an assessment of the impact of a proposed rule on the families
- 24 of the state of Washington and include the assessment as an attachment
- 25 to the notice of a proposed rule under RCW 34.05.320. The agency head
- 26 shall be guided by the policies stated in RCW 74.14A.020 and 74.14A.025
- 27 and the criteria in section 4 of this act when preparing the assessment
- 28 required by this section.
- 29 NEW SECTION. Sec. 4. A new section is added to chapter 34.05 RCW
- 30 to read as follows:
- 31 An agency preparing an assessment under section 3 of this act shall
- 32 determine the following:

- 1 (1) Does the proposed rule strengthen or erode the stability of the 2 family and, particularly, the marital commitment;
- 3 (2) Does the proposed rule strengthen or erode the authority and 4 rights of parents in the education, nurture, and supervision of their 5 children;
- 6 (3) Does the proposed rule help the family perform its functions, 7 or substitute governmental activity for the function;
- 8 (4) Does the proposed rule increase or decrease disposable family 9 income;
- 10 (5) Do the proposed benefits of the rule justify the financial 11 impact on the family;
- 12 (6) Would the policy being pursued in the proposed rule be better 13 implemented by local government or by the family; and
- 14 (7) Does the proposed rule establish an implicit or explicit policy 15 concerning the status of the family, the relationship between the 16 behavior and personal responsibility of youth, and the norms of 17 society.
- NEW SECTION. Sec. 5. A new section is added to chapter 34.05 RCW to read as follows:
- If requested by a member of the legislature to assess the impact of a proposed rule on the families of the state of Washington under section 3 of this act, the agency head shall:
- 23 (1) Submit a written certification to the director of financial 24 management that the proposed rule has been assessed in accordance with 25 this act;
- 26 (2) Provide an adequate rationale for implementation of any aspect 27 of the rule that may negatively affect family well-being; and
- 28 (3) Attach a copy of the information described in subsections (1)
- 29 and (2) of this section to the notice of the proposed rule issued under
- 30 RCW 34.05.320.
- 31 <u>NEW SECTION.</u> **Sec. 6.** This act takes effect January 1, 1999."
- 32 Correct the title.
- 33 <u>EFFECT:</u> Limits assessments to state agency rules, and only upon 34 request of a legislator. Provides a definition of "family." Specifies

1 criteria for assessing impact on families, and deletes requirement for 2 the Family Policy Council to develop guidelines.
