7 NEW SECTION. **Sec. 1.** The legislature finds that increased
8 communications between local law enforcement officers and the state
9 department of corrections' community corrections officers improves
10 public safety through shared monitoring and supervision of offenders
11 living in the community under the jurisdiction of the department of
12 corrections.

13 Participating local law enforcement agencies and the local offices
14 of the department of corrections have implemented, on a pilot basis,
15 the supervision management and recidivist tracking program, whereby
16 each entity provides mutual assistance in supervising offenders living
17 within the boundaries of local law enforcement agencies. The
18 supervision management and recidivist tracking program has helped local
19 law enforcement solve crimes faster or prevented future criminal
20 activity by reporting offender's sentence violations in a more timely
21 manner to community corrections officers by rapid and comprehensive
22 electronic sharing of information regarding supervised offenders. The
23 expansion of the supervision management and recidivist tracking program
24 will improve public safety throughout the state.

25 NEW SECTION. **Sec. 2.** A new section is added to chapter 43.10 RCW
26 to read as follows:

27 There is created, as a component of the homicide investigative
28 tracking system, a supervision management and recidivist tracking
29 system called the SMART system. The office of the attorney general may
30 contract with any state, local, or private agency necessary for
31 implementation of supervision management and recidivist tracking
32 program partnerships for development and operation of a state-wide
33 computer linkage between the attorney general's homicide investigative
34 tracking system, local police departments, and the state department of
35 corrections. No information on any person may be entered into the

1 SMART system, or retained in the system, unless the person is under the
2 jurisdiction of the department of corrections. The department of
3 corrections shall notify the attorney general when each person is no
4 longer under its supervision.

5 NEW SECTION. **Sec. 3.** If specific funding for purposes of this
6 act, referencing this act by bill or chapter number, is not provided by
7 June 30, 1997, in the omnibus appropriations act, this act is null and
8 void."

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12 On page 1, line 2 of the title, after "corrections;" strike the
13 remainder of the title and insert "adding a new section to chapter
14 43.10 RCW; and creating new sections."

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
