5 On page 6, after line 18, insert the following:

6 "NEW SECTION. **Sec. 5.** Any municipal electric utility formed by a
7 municipality with a population of more than four hundred thousand as of
8 the effective date of this section shall submit a report to its
9 governing body by December 1, 1998, with the following information:

10 (1) The ratio of the municipal electric utility's customers to its
11 employees as of the effective date of this section, and the changes in
12 the ratio that have occurred over the previous ten years; and

13 (2) The annual sources of funding and the amount of annual
14 expenditures, including federal funds, by the municipal electric
15 utility on conservation, renewable resources, and low-income
16 weatherization and energy bill-paying assistance programs during the
17 previous ten years. This part of the report shall describe: (i) the
18 amount of electricity saved by such conservation programs; (ii) the
19 overhead costs to the municipal electric utility to administer such
20 programs, including but not limited to amounts expended by other
21 municipal departments and nonprofit entities in administering such
22 programs; and (iii) for low-income weatherization programs, the
23 overhead cost per unit weatherized as compared to the overhead costs of
24 comparable programs administered by the state. "

26 references accordingly.
