- 7 "NEW SECTION. Sec. 1. (1) The legislature finds that protection 8 insurance consumers likely is enhanced by insurers' voluntary 9 compliance with this state's insurance and other laws and that the 10 public will benefit from incentives to identify and remedy insurance and other compliance issues. One method to encourage insurers both to 11 conduct voluntary internal audits of their compliance programs and 12 13 management systems and to assess and improve compliance with state and federal statutes, rules, and orders, is to provide an insurance 14 15 compliance self-evaluative privilege to protect the confidentiality of 16 communications relating to voluntary internal compliance audits. The 17 legislature intends to study public policy issues regarding a limited privilege to encourage voluntary compliance and improve insurance 18 19 market conduct quality, and whether the expanded privilege could 20 inhibit the exercise of the regulatory authority by those entrusted with protecting insurance consumers. 21
- (2) The house financial institutions and insurance committee and 22 23 the senate financial institutions, insurance and housing committee 24 shall jointly study insurance compliance self-evaluative audits and 25 make recommendations on whether a limited privilege should be 26 authorized in Washington state to encourage such audits. The chairs of 27 the two committees shall oversee the study. If the recommendations include authorizing the limited privilege, the study shall develop a 28 bill for consideration in the 1999 legislative session. 29
- 30 (3) The two committee chairs shall organize a study group that includes the voluntary participation of the insurance industry, the 31 office of the insurance commissioner, and other interested parties. 32 33 The ranking minority members of each committee shall also participate
- 34 in the study group.
- 35 (4) The house office of program research and senate committee 36 services shall staff the study group.

- 1 (5) The recommendations of the study group are due by December 31, 2 1998. This section expires January 1, 1999."
