13 permit applications, conducting basin assessments, continued
14 implementation of water resources data management systems, setting
15 instream flows, and providing technical and data support to local
16 watershed planning and implementation efforts. Of this amount,
17 \$129,000 of the fiscal year 1998 and \$130,000 of the fiscal year 1999
18 appropriation are provided for the establishment of interagency
19 watershed teams consisting of the departments of fish and wildlife;
20 ecology; community, trade, and economic development; and health to
21 provide assistance to local watershed planning efforts based on an
