EFFECT: The endowment for higher education now has two purposes: (1) To provide scholarships for meritorious and needy students to attend the college of their choice in Washington state, and (2) to assist institutions of higher education in creating endowments financed

jointly by public and private moneys. Fifty percent of appropriated funds go the endowments and fifty percent of appropriated funds go to scholarships. The scholarships will be available for students who attend any higher education institution in the state whether public or private.
