2 **SSJM 8010** - S AMD - 599 3 By Senator Strannigan ADOPTED 2/11/98 4 5 Beginning on page 1, line 9, strike the remainder of the memorial and insert the following: 6 7 "WHEREAS, The Secretary of Transportation has prescribed motor vehicle safety standards under the authority of the National Traffic 8 9 and Motor Vehicle Safety Act of 1966; and WHEREAS, The current standards require that vehicles be equipped 10 11 with an automatic occupant crash protection system consisting of lap and shoulder seat belts and an inflatable restraint device otherwise 12 13 known as an "airbag" in the two front seating positions; and 14 WHEREAS, Despite recent actions to authorize installation of redesigned airbag devices in new vehicles, many serious and dangerous 15 16 safety problems remain unaddressed; and WHEREAS, Millions of vehicles on our roads, and some in our 17 driveways, have older model airbags; and 18 WHEREAS, The newly announced process for installation of airbag 19 20 deactivation switches is overly limiting, cumbersome, and requires the 21 permission of federal authorities; and 22 WHEREAS, Airbags do save lives, but due to these unaddressed problems, airbags continue to be responsible for the shocking and 23 24 gruesome deaths of any children and adults; and 25 WHEREAS, This situation has effectively rendered the front 26 passenger side seating area in many vehicles useless in a large number 27 of cases; and 28 WHEREAS, It is possible to improve upon this situation; and

29 WHEREAS, Federal law expressly preempts states from altering present standards or enacting other safety standards in this field; 30 31 NOW, THEREFORE, Your Memorialists respectfully pray that the United States Congress and the United States Department of Transportation 32 adopt new laws, regulations, and standards to protect the safety of 33 occupants of passenger vehicles by encouraging the installation of 34 35 airbag systems where the driver, free from government supervision, has 36 the ability to deactivate the driver's side and passenger side airbag 37 in any type of vehicle.

BE IT RESOLVED, That copies of this Memorial be immediately transmitted to the Honorable William J. Clinton, President of the United States, the Secretary of the United States Department of Transportation, the President of the United States Senate, the Speaker of the House of Representatives, and each member of Congress from the State of Washington."
