

# HOUSE BILL REPORT

## ESHB 2259

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### As Passed House

April 26, 1997

**Title:** An act relating to fiscal matters.

**Brief Description:** Making appropriations for the fiscal biennium ending June 30, 1999.

**Sponsors:** By House Committee on Appropriations (originally sponsored by Representatives Huff, H. Sommers, Dickerson and Conway; by request of Governor Locke).

**Staff:** Victor Moore (786-7143).

**Background:** The state government operates on the basis of a fiscal biennium that begins on July 1 of each odd-numbered year.

**Summary of Bill:** The 1997-99 Omnibus Appropriations Act is passed, making appropriations for the 1997-99 biennium. The state general fund total is \$18.994 billion.

**Appropriation:** See bill.

**Fiscal Note:** Not requested.

**Effective Date:** The bill contains an emergency clause and takes effect on July 1, 1997.
