Each PUD is divided into three commissioner districts ach with approximately he same population and the commission endistricts eused for residency urposes for any candidate for the commission position much that district and only voters esiding the district vote at a primary to nominate candidates for the commission position much that district the vote at the general election electe ach commissioner.

Votersofa PUD may authorize he board of commissioners obecome a five-member board if the PUD has a population of 500,000 or more or if the PUD has a license from the Federal Power Commission to construct hydroelectric oject of an estimated ostof more than \$250 million of the voters authorize he increase the PUD is divided nto two commissioner districts that with approximate by he same population or the election of the two additions of missioners. This second set of commissioner districts in addition the normal set of three commissioner districts, which stills used to elect the other three commissioners. The additionative commissioners recelected ost aggered our-year moso of fice but the other three commissioners are still ected ost aggered ix-year erms of of fice.

SUMMARY:

Voters of a PUD are authorized o reduce the terms of office of the three commissioner from sixto four years.

The petition resolution ausing aballoproposition be submitted overs authorizing the reation appropriate PUD must specify the therefore missioners ilserve staggered our-year six-year erms of office Provision remade to stagge the terms of office the initial mmissioners far PUD is created teither ix-year erms or four-year erms of office.

Votersofany PUD areauthorized bincreast the number of commissioner from three to five members. The use of the two districts ed to elect the fourthand fifth commissioner is clarifited be for residency and nomination purposes only.

A singleallopropositionay include oth proposal to increase the number of commissioner to five and to reduce the terms of office f the three commissioners from sixto four years.
