If the challength smade less than 30 days before an election primary including challength by a precinct lection of fices the polling site the challenge dotervotes using a challenge dallot that is secured a part from other cast ballots a hearings the matter and determinations made by the county can vassing oard after the election Only a precinct lection of fice may challenge person's gight ovote at a polling ite.

SUMMARY:

A precincelection ffice must require hat each person appearing the polling site who announces his orher intento vote, show identification the precinct election ffice meels sufficient identify he person as being the registered voter. Identification be shown by means of a Washington State driver's license denticated sue by the Department of Licensing in ited States passport, or United States military lentification.

Failure opresents ufficient dentificate constitutes ounds for a precinct elections fice to challengtheright a person to vote.
