Preparation Submission fa Fisca Note

The Officeof Financia Management (OFM-), or the Department of Community, Trade and Economic Development (DCTED-) as OFM's designee is required to complete the fiscal otewithin 2 hours unless the requesting egislata belows longer time period. Neither the absence of a fiscal otenor in accuracy fa fiscal note:

- prevent&heLegislatufromactingpon proposedlegislation;
- affectshevalidity any legislatithmatispassed by the Legislature.

OFM (orDCTED ifdesignated)srequiredoprovideopiesofthecompletedfiscal notetotherequestingegislatand to:

- the chair of the committee which holds or has acted upon the bil (House or Senate);
- thechairoftheLocalGovernmentCommittee(HouseorSenate);
- theSecretaryftheSenate(Senatebills);
- theChiefClerkoftheHouse ofRepresentativeHousebills);
- forSenatebillshechainftheWays and Means Committee and
- forHouse billsthe chairsof the Revenue and Taxationand Appropriation Committees.

A localgovernmentfiscarlotemay be requested only by the chair or the ranking minority member of the localgovernment committee or equivalent ommittee considering or calcovernment matters from each house. The authority or any other legislattor equesta local overnment fiscarlote is eliminated.

The initimal questiona local government fiscal oteis to be considered continuing requestwith respect to a fiscal oteon any substitutes amendments to the original version of the billion which the local government fiscal otewas requested in less:

The timelimiforcompleting equest for local overnment fiscal otesis expanded from the current hour limit OFM (or DCTED if lesignated) required complete a local overnment fiscal otewith in one week of request.

These responsibilitimes uda general prohibition expending funds in excess of the state expenditure in it and a requirement or eimburse ocal overnments for the costs of new programs or increase in service evels.

A new section is added to chapter 43.132 RCW providing or fiscal totes on legislations seed uring the five earperiod receding request The chair ranking minority member of the local government committee (or equivalent committee considering cadovernment matters and request hat OFM (or DCTED if lesignated) prepare local overnment fiscal oteon any legislation acted within the last five years. A local overnment fiscal oteon enacted legislatics to be prepared and treated in the same manner as a fiscal oteon proposed legislation.
