BACKGROUND:

Initiat 276 was approved by voter in 1972. Among other equirement in the 276 require arious reports from paigness penditures be filewith the Public Disclosur commission (PDC) and county auditors.

Each <u>candidate</u> and <u>politices</u> immittee is required of ile reports its contributions received and expenditures de, since ilimbelast reportation following tervals: (1) on the 21 st day and 7 th day immediately receding heelection 2 on the 10 th day of the first tonth after the election 2 (3) on the 10 day of each month in which no other eportare required be filed.

Each person who makes an independent expenditure \$100 or more during hesame election ampaigning upport for opposition a candidater ball of proposition does not otherwise ave to file reports a candidater politice must file report the independent expenditure the following nterval (sl.) On the 21 st day and 7 th day immediately receding he election (2) on the 10 day of the first month after the election of (3) on the 10 day of each month in which no other report are required be filed.
