The EthicsinPublicervicect prohibits tateoffice and employees from seeking or accepting ertaignifts Generally tateoffice and employees are not allowed to accept gifts worth more than \$50. The value of gifts given to an officer or employee's family member is included then determining the \$50 limits been exceeded unless the family member has an independent elations with the donor.

The act excludesseveralitems from the definition gift.—Items from family members or friends hat are clearly otdesigned to gain in fluence reexcluded from the definition Another exclusion allows state of ficers and employees to accept payment of enrollmentees and reasonable rave expenses to attend seminars or education of programs. The programs must be sponsored by a nonprofit of essional, education of tradessociation charitable stitution.
