BACKGROUND:

The MunicipaResearchCouncilisa stateagencythatcontracts have municipal researched services rovided forcities and towns. The councils composed of 18 members: (1) Four appointed by the Speaker of the House with equal representation from each of the two major politics are the four appointed by the President fithe Senate with equal representation meach of the two major politics and town of ficials appointed by the Governor and (4) ninecity and town of ficials appointed by the board of directors the Association Washington Cities The activities services the Municipa Research Council are carried in cooperation with the Association Washington Cities.

For years the Municipalesearch Council has contracted ith the Municipalesearch and Service Senter of Washington a private on profitor poration opprovide hese services or cities and towns.

Money appropriated the Legislature fund the Municipa Research Councilis diverted from statemotor vehicle scisetax receipts hat otherwise would be distributed cities and towns on a percapit basis.
