1 AN ACT Relating to identification; adding a new chapter to Title 19
2 RCW; and prescribing penalties.

3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF WASHINGTON:

4 NEW SECTION. **Sec. 1.** (1) The following are official forms of
5 establishing proof of identity:

6 (a) A valid or recently expired driver's license or instruction
7 permit that contains the signature, date of birth, and a photograph of
8 the person;

9 (b) A Washington state identicard or an identification card issued
10 by another state that contains the signature and a photograph of the
11 person;

12 (c) An identification card issued by the United States, a state, or
13 an agency of either the United States or a state, of a kind commonly
14 used to identify the members of employees of the government agency,
15 that contain the signature and a photograph of the person;

16 (d) A military identification card that contains the signature and
17 a photograph of the person;

18 (e) A United States passport that contains the signature and a
19 photograph of the person;

1 (f) An immigration and naturalization service form that contains
2 the signature and photograph of the person;

3 (g) A merchant marine identification card issued by the United
4 States Coast Guard; or

5 (h) A liquor control authority card of identification issued by any
6 state or province of Canada.

7 (2) Any other person or entity who issues cards, forms, or other
8 documents purporting to identify the holder shall plainly label each
9 card, form, or other document "not official proof of identification."

10 (3) Failure to comply with this section is a class 1 civil
11 infraction.

12 NEW SECTION. **Sec. 2.** Section 1 of this act constitutes a new
13 chapter in Title 19 RCW.
