- AN ACT Relating to notification of student testing or survey; and
- 2 adding a new section to chapter 28A.600 RCW.
- 3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF WASHINGTON:
- 4 <u>NEW SECTION.</u> **Sec. 1.** A new section is added to chapter 28A.600 5 RCW to read as follows:
- 6 (1) Except when generated by a student as a part of coursework, a
- 7 public school must give parents or legal guardians advance written
- 8 notice before the school, or before any person or organization under
- 9 contract with the school, conducts any student test, questionnaire,
- 10 survey, analysis, or evaluation that requests disclosure by the student
- 11 of information about either the student or the student's parent or
- 12 legal guardian's personal: Political or religious affiliations, mental
- 13 or psychological problems, sexual behavior or attitudes, illegal, self-
- 14 incriminating, or demeaning behavior, critical appraisals of any other
- 15 individual with whom the student has a family relationship, legally
- 16 privileged information arising out of confidential relationships with
- 17 persons such as lawyers, physicians, or ministers, or religious issues.
- 18 The notice must provide complete disclosure to the student's parent or

- legal guardian regarding the subject matter and nature of the test, questionnaire, survey, analysis, or evaluation.
- 3 (2) No student may participate in any test, questionnaire, survey, 4 analysis, or evaluation listed in subsection (1) of this section 5 without prior written consent from the student's parent or legal 6 guardian.
- 7 (3) All materials that a school uses in conducting any student 8 test, questionnaire, survey, analysis, or evaluation that involves 9 disclosure of information described in subsection (1) of this section 10 must be readily available for inspection by the parent or legal 11 guardian of a student, at least ten days before their administration, 12 at the school during normal school hours. School personnel must also 13 be readily available to answer questions relative to the materials.
