- 4 <u>NEW SECTION.</u> **Sec. 1.** The legislature recognizes that the large,
- 5 hairy prehistoric elephants of the extinct genus Mammuthus roamed the
- 6 north American continent, including the Pacific Northwest, during the
- 7 Pleistocene epoch (Ice Ages).
- 8 NEW SECTION. Sec. 2. A new section is added to chapter 1.20 RCW
- 9 to read as follows:
- 10 The Columbian mammoth of North America, Mammuthus COLUMBI, is
- 11 hereby designated as the official fossil of the state of Washington.
