- 5 <u>NEW SECTION.</u> **Sec. 1.** A new section is added to chapter 90.03 RCW
- 6 to read as follows:
- 7 Nothing in this title authorizes the department of ecology to
- 8 withdraw Columbia or Snake river waters from further appropriation
- 9 based upon uncertainty as to whether sufficient waters would be
- 10 available, following new appropriations, to satisfy the needs of any
- 11 unquantified or speculative future instream uses of the waters of these
- 12 rivers.
- 13 <u>NEW SECTION.</u> **Sec. 2.** A new section is added to chapter 43.21A RCW
- 14 to read as follows:
- 15 (1) The department of ecology shall not withdraw Columbia or Snake
- 16 river waters from further appropriation based upon uncertainty as to
- 17 whether sufficient waters would be available, following new

- appropriations, to satisfy the needs of any unquantified or speculative future instream uses of the waters of these rivers.
- 3 (2) WAC 173-563-015 and 173-564-040 as they existed prior to the 4 effective date of this section are in conflict with subsection (1) of 5 this section and are void.
- NEW SECTION. Sec. 3. A new section is added to chapter 43.27A RCW 7 to read as follows:
- 8 (1) The department of ecology shall not withdraw Columbia or Snake 9 river waters from further appropriation based upon uncertainty as to 10 whether sufficient waters would be available, following new 11 appropriations, to satisfy the needs of any unquantified or speculative 12 future instream uses of the waters of these rivers.
- 13 (2) WAC 173-563-015 and 173-564-040 as they existed prior to the 14 effective date of this section are in conflict with subsection (1) of 15 this section and are void.
