## HOUSE BILL 1182

- 1 AN ACT Relating to sales and use tax relief for law enforcement
- 2 agencies; adding a new section to chapter 82.08 RCW; adding a new
- 3 section to chapter 82.12 RCW; and providing an effective date.
- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF WASHINGTON:
- 5 <u>NEW SECTION.</u> **Sec. 1.** A new section is added to chapter 82.08 RCW 6 to read as follows:
- 7 The tax levied by RCW 82.08.020 does not apply to sales to general
- 8 authority law enforcement agencies. The sole method of administering
- 9 this exemption is by refund as provided in this section.
- 10 As used in this section, "general authority law enforcement agency"
- 11 has the meaning given to "general authority Washington law enforcement
- 12 agency" in RCW 10.93.020, except "general authority law enforcement
- 13 agency" is not limited to Washington agencies. "General authority law
- 14 enforcement agency" also includes the criminal justice training
- 15 commission.
- 16 Buyers eligible for an exemption under this section shall pay tax
- 17 to the seller as otherwise required under this chapter. The buyer may
- 18 then apply to the department for refund of tax paid including tax paid
- 19 on the same taxable event under chapter 82.14 RCW. Along with the

- 1 application, the buyer shall include invoices, receipts, or other
- 2 documentation establishing the amount of tax paid, the seller, and the
- 3 location of the sale. The department shall make refunds under this
- 4 section at least quarterly.
- 5 Moneys refunded under this section shall be used solely for
- 6 criminal justice purposes.
- 7 NEW SECTION. Sec. 2. A new section is added to chapter 82.12 RCW
- 8 to read as follows:
- 9 The provisions of this chapter do not apply with respect to any use
- 10 by general authority law enforcement agencies, as defined in section 1
- 11 of this act.
- 12 <u>NEW SECTION.</u> **Sec. 3.** This act takes effect August 1, 1997.
