The district court may exercise concurrent jurisdiction with the superior court in all actions and proceedings set forth in subsection (1) of this section where the value of the claim exceeds thirty-five thousand dollars but does not exceed fifty thousand dollars, exclusive of interest, costs, and attorneys' fees, if the district court has agreed to exercise such jurisdiction.
