- 1 AN ACT Relating to telemedicine; adding a new section to chapter
- 2 18.71 RCW; and creating a new section.
- 3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF WASHINGTON:
- 4 NEW SECTION. Sec. 1. The legislature finds that:
- 5 (1) Telecommunications technology has made it possible to provide
- 6 a wide range of health care services across state lines between
- 7 physicians and patients.
- 8 (2) The delivery of health services by licensed physicians is a
- 9 privilege conditioned upon the protection of the health and safety of
- 10 the patient and the accountability of medical practice under the
- 11 procedures and sanctions for unprofessional conduct governed by the
- 12 uniform disciplinary act, chapter 18.130 RCW.
- 13 <u>NEW SECTION.</u> **Sec. 2.** A new section is added to chapter 18.71 RCW
- 14 to read as follows:
- 15 (1) A nonresident physician who provides direct care through tele-
- 16 electronic means to a patient residing in this state must be sponsored
- 17 by a physician licensed to practice and residing in this state.

(2) The medical quality assurance commission may define by rule the parameters for providing direct care through tele-electronic means, including guidelines for sponsoring nonresident licensed physicians.

(3) "Direct care" means advice or direction rendered by a nonresident physician taking primary responsibility for a patient's care that directly determines the course of care without any independent decision making by the resident physician attending the patient, but does not include rendering a diagnosis or providing consultation.
